Policy Title: Scholarships and Bursaries Policy

Policy Number: 2015-07

Date Approved: 2025-01-21

Purpose: To establish a policy which benefits graduating community youth directly from the Clinton and District Community Forest Ltd.

Recommendations for Scholarships/Bursaries:

1. Successful applicants will be graduates from David Stoddard School
2. Up to \$4000.00 will be awarded to successful applicants at the discretion of the Board- up to \$2000.00 for the Clinton and District Community Forest of BC Bursary AND up to \$2000.00 for the Henk Hanemaayer Memorial Bursary
3. The procedure to apply is:
 - a) open to any graduate, who is a permanent resident of Canada;
 - b) submission of latest report card and a reference letter from a teacher;
 - c) acceptance to a post-secondary institution;
 - d) enrolment must be confirmed before award funds are granted;
 - e) an essay of at least 250 words on the advantage of having a community forest in the Clinton area is required;

- f) applications must be received by May 15;
- g) applicants to be interviewed by 2 Directors;
- h) answer 5 recommended interview questions (please see attached list);
- i) the successful applicant must be enrolled in a post-secondary institution within 2 academic years of the awarding of the scholarship/bursary
